Self catering chalets

Rates include

- Fully equipped holiday homes
- All bed linen (excluding towels)

Small Chalet (maximum 8 persons) – 2 available

Single storey terraced chalets. Open plan kitchen/dining area and living room. Bathroom with shower, toilet, and wash-hand basin.

Sleeping arrangements: bunk beds in 2 bedrooms.

Cost: £400

Medium Chalet (maximum 10 persons) – 3 available

Single storey terraced chalets. Open plan kitchen/dining area and living room. 3 en suite bedrooms.

Sleeping arrangements: bunk beds in 2 bedrooms x 4 persons; 1 bedroom x 2 persons.

Cost: £450

Large Chalet (maximum 12 persons) – 6 available

Single storey detached bungalows. Open plan kitchen with large dining and living room. 3 en suite bedrooms.

Sleeping arrangements: bunk beds in 3 bedrooms.

Cost: £480

Chalets are available from 12 noon on day of arrival and must be vacated by 10.30 am on the day of departure. Families may organise themselves into groups with the accommodation plan in mind.

Caravan and campsite fees

- Touring Caravan** £25.00 per night
- Camping** £7.00 per person per night

All sites have electric link up if required.

Off-site accommodation

If you prefer to book your own accommodation you are welcome to join the Family Holiday programme and worship sessions.
