Recently, Thomas and a team of political aspirants, were touring around villages outside the small town of Wamba in Samburu County. A 25 year old man appeared in the crowd with a huge growth on the side of his neck. When asked about the problem, the team were told that the growth had been developing for six years. The hospitals nearby did not have the medical equipment necessary to perform an operation and, because of poverty, the man was unable to go elsewhere to receive treatment.

But help came from one aspirant's connection with a surgeon in Kenyatta hospital in Nairobi. The whole village rallied round to raise the funds covering his travel expenses to the capital. When the operation took place last week, it was a success and happily the growth wasn't cancerous. Pray for him as he continues recovering.
