Sunday 15 September

- **Moderator** | *The Moderator will be leading the services at Seskinore (200th anniversary) and Ballykeel (50th anniversary) today. Pray that these two congregations may feel encouraged as they reflect on the work they have accomplished over the years and as they anticipate the ways in which God will direct their ministry in the future.*
