Sunday 19 October

- Moderator | This week, please pray for the Moderator as he plans and prepares for the presbytery tour which will take place in Armagh next year. The Moderator will also be opening the meeting of the Council for Global Mission and attending the World Development Appeal Launch.

Monday 20 October
